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TERMS & CONDITIONS (STALLHOLDERS 2017)

- 1. CONTRACT** A contract to provide a stall will only be in place when:
(1) **Payment is received** and (2) **We have confirmed your booking in writing, or by e-mail.** Any payment received which does not lead to a confirmed booking will be returned. The organisers maintain the right to refuse an application without any reason. All information given on the application should be complete and correct at the time the entry is submitted. You should advise any changes to the Organisers, in writing, as soon as possible.
- 2. REFUNDS** No refunds will be made in the event of adverse weather conditions, poor attendance or sales, or in the event of any other circumstances outside the control of the Organisers.
- 3. USE OF STALL** Once our confirmation has been received, no change of use or addition to your stall can be made without our written permission in advance. Stallholders must not encroach on, or block access to, any other stall. The sharing of space, except with specific written permission from the Organisers, is not permitted.
- 4. BANNED ITEMS** NO alcohol as prizes to anybody under the age of 18. NO alcohol for sale. NO guns, catapults or other weapons. NO offensive literature or pictures. NO illegal drugs.
- 5. RUBBISH** All unsold items, packaging, rubbish, etc. is the responsibility of the stall-holder and must be taken away by the stall-holder.
- 6. INSURANCE** The stallholder will be responsible for insuring their own property and take sensible precautions to guard against its loss or damage.
- 7. SAFETY** All stallholders must take reasonable precautions for themselves and visitors to their stalls, keeping walkways clear of all obstructions, flagpoles, signs, etc. No vehicles may be moved on site during the hours that the event is open to the public (11am to 5pm)

WHY & HOW & WHO?

Why do we put the Festival on?

To show local people & visitors what a wonderful place the canal is, to support local boating, boat clubs & the community by keeping the event inclusive by FREE admission.

How do we do it?

Our Management Team of 11 works all year to plan the Festival and swells to 90 additional Volunteers on the day putting in a total of 2500 hours a year.

We are a not-for-profit organisation and currently need to raise £23,000 to stage the event.
